


Failure to mount the air spring correctly may cause the mounting clips to break, causing improper fitment resulting in leakage.





IMPROPER INFLATION EXAMPLES

Air springs inflated without following the manufacturer's specifications/not supporting the vehicle can cause the force to distribute unevenly, which may result in crimp ring failure.
